Register To Vote

Voting is one of our most sacred American rights. In order to exercise it, though, you have to be registered. If you need to register for the first time or update your current voter registration, you can do it online at: <https://vrsws.sos.ky.gov/ovrweb/govoteky>.

The deadline to register for the November 8th election is 4PM, Tuesday, October 11th. Information on Absentee Voting is also available at that same web address.



Same Police / New Name

The Graymoor-Devondale Police Department is now the Lyndon Police Department. Although the name is new, their service to Beechwood Village remains unchanged.

Using the same officers we already know, the Lyndon Police will continue to patrol and respond in Beechwood Village, just as they have for several years.

As a benefit from joining a larger city, the Lyndon Police will now be able to expand their staff. Plans include extra officers, an additional detective, and a social worker to assist with mental health-related calls.

Plant A Tree & Save Money, Too

Our popular half-price Fall tree planting program returns for 2022. Residents may choose from four tree varieties: Red Maple, Willow Oak, Sugar Maple, and Tulip Poplar. The trees are about 2 inches in diameter and 12-15 feet tall. Trees will be planted by Frank Otte Nursery from late November to mid-December.

While the total cost of each tree is \$450, the homeowner only pays \$225. The other \$225 is covered by Beechwood Village. You choose the tree, and the city pays half!

Get A Great Part-Time Job

This fall, Beechwood Village will elect a new Mayor and six-member City Council. Unfortunately, no candidates filed to run for Mayor, and too few candidates filed for the City Council.

These are paid, part-time positions. City Council members serve two-year terms, and earn \$2,400/year. The Mayor serves a four-year term with an annual salary of \$8,000.

While the ballot deadline has passed, there is still time to qualify as a Write-In candidate for any city office. Write-Ins must be officially registered for their votes to count.
